

Sweater-Knit Top and Skirt Project by Mary Jane Allen
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Supplies:

Fine-gauge sweater knit top

Style Pattern # 2670 (to make a skirt)

Floral fabric, interfacing, zipper and thread, as indicated on pattern envelope

Polymesh stabilizer (lightweight cutaway)

Water-soluble stabilizer

Black rayon thread

Flower Designs from Perfect Little Stitches

Sew the skirt according to the pattern.

Try on the top to determine the vertical placement for the design. The design should be centered horizontally. Use pins to mark the location. Hoop polymesh stabilizer. Position the top over the stabilizer so that the area to be embroidered is centered within the embroidery field. Cover with a layer of water-soluble stabilizer. Pin the three layers (polymesh, knit top and water-soluble stabilizer), placing pins all around the design area. Use about 16 pins (or more!). Be sure none of the pins are inside the area of embroidery.

Embroider the Flower Design. Remove excess water-soluble stabilizer. Trim the polymesh close to the design. Rinse out remaining water-soluble stabilizer.

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
